⁽²⁾ Tangible shareholders' equity equals total shareholders' equity less goodwill and identifiable intangible assets. Management believes that tangible shareholders' equity is a meaningful measure because it reflects the equity deployed in the firm's businesses. Annualized return on average tangible shareholders' equity is computed by dividing annualized net earnings by average monthly tangible shareholders' equity. Tangible book value per share is computed by dividing tangible shareholders' equity by the number of common shares outstanding, including restricted stock units granted to employees with no future service requirements.
